WEBSITE'S COOKIE POLICY

OF BREAKUP AND DIVORCE GLOBAL LIMITED.

Your Option to Opt Out of or to Agree to Cookie Use by Breakup and Divorce Global Limited

Website owners should obtain explicit consent from visitors before leaving behind or reading files

(mostly cookies) on user's computers.

a. Opting out:

(i) To opt out of being tracked by Google, use the pop-up form on our website.

(ii) To opt out of being tracked by Google Analytics across all websites, including Sara Davison Global Enterprises Limited, visit: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>

b. Agreeing:

However, if you register your details with Breakup and Divorce Global Limited, or if you continue to use our website without opting out, then it is understood and accepted that you thereby agree to

our use of cookies.

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a piece of data stored on a user's computer, which is linked to information about the user's

activity. Cookies are an important feature of the Internet as they facilitate the operation of a website and

allow smoother use of many of its useful features. Cookies have many different uses. Some are essential for allowing you to navigate around a website and to use its features - without these cookies,

the services you wish may not be able to be provided.

Use of Cookies by Breakup and Divorce Global Limited

Breakup and Divorce Global Limited may use both 'session ID' cookies and 'persistent' cookies.

When you close your browser or leave the Breakup and Divorce Global Limited site, session ID cookies end their use and are erased. By contrast, persistent cookies are small text files which are

stored on your computer's hard drive for an extended period of time. Cookies used on the Sara Davison

Global Enterprises Limited website do not contain personally identifiable information about you that

could be used either for marketing or for remembering where you've been on the Internet.

Furthermore,

any data gleaned from our use of cookies is not shared with any third parties.

Analytics

Cookies used by Breakup and Divorce Global Limited help us to keep track of those of our pages and links which are popular and also to see which of our pages and links are not used so much.

This

cookie usage assists us in keeping our site up-to-date and relevant. Cookies also help us to see the

trend of how people navigate our sites and to alert us as to whether visitors get 'error messages' from

our web pages. This group of cookies - often called 'analytics cookies' - are used to gather such information. They are both sessional and persistent cookies. They do not collect information that

identifies you. All the data collected is anonymous and is grouped with the information from the cookies

of all other visitors. This group data shows us the overall patterns of usage, rather than any one person's activity. Analytics cookies only record activity on the site you are on and they are only used to

improve how our website works.
